

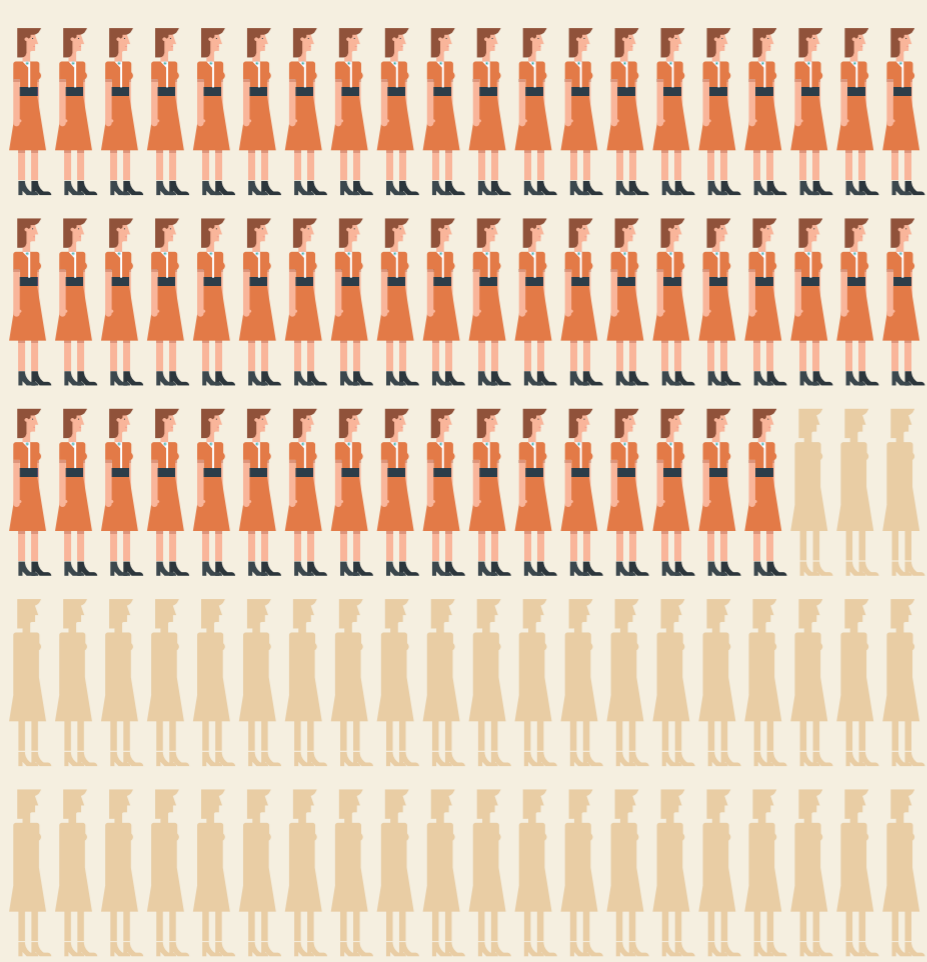
WOMEN'S ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT IN GEORGIA

In Georgia, women's economic activity rate is 20% lower than men's.

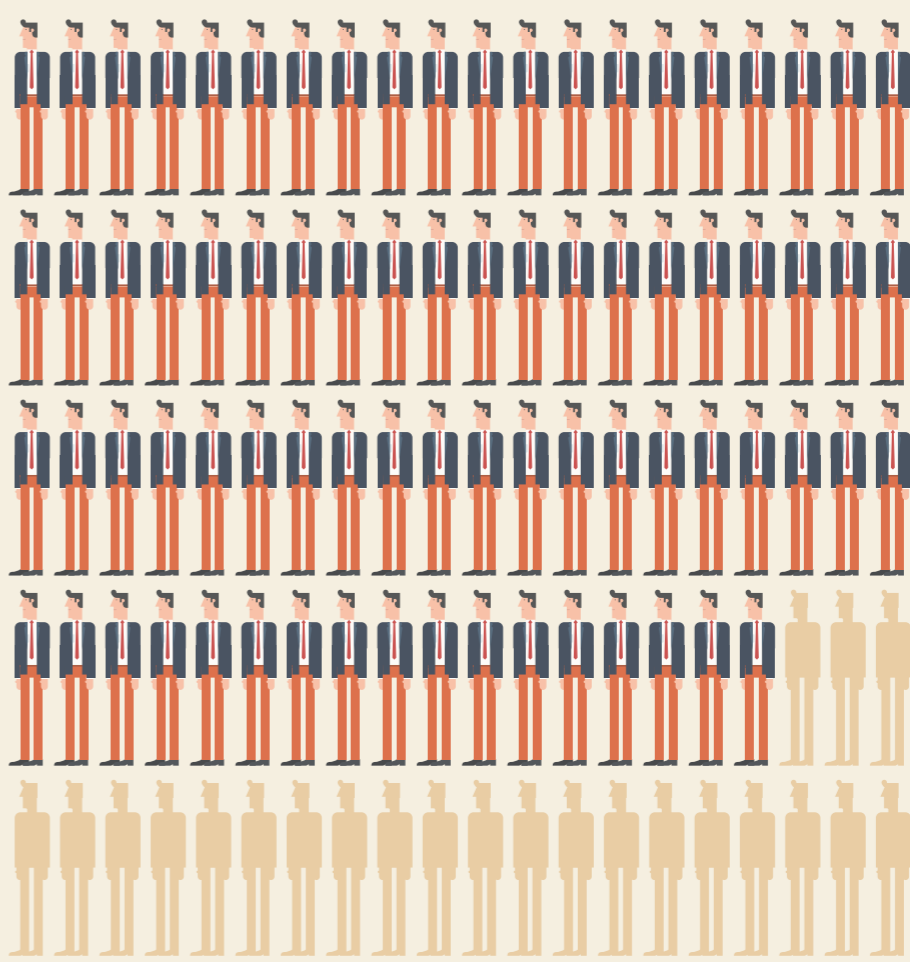
Which means that



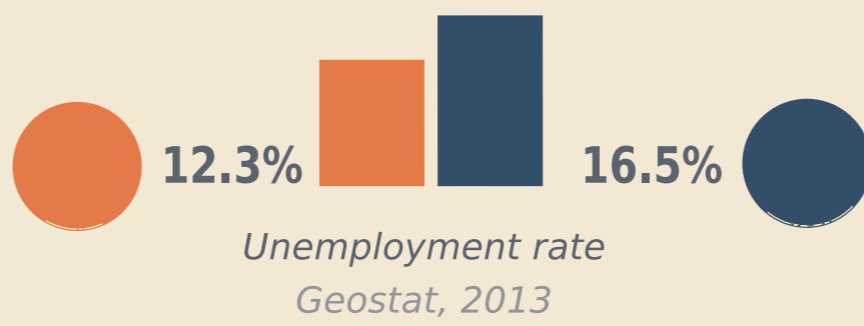
Out of every **100** women **57** are employed or are looking for a job



And out of every **100** men - **77**



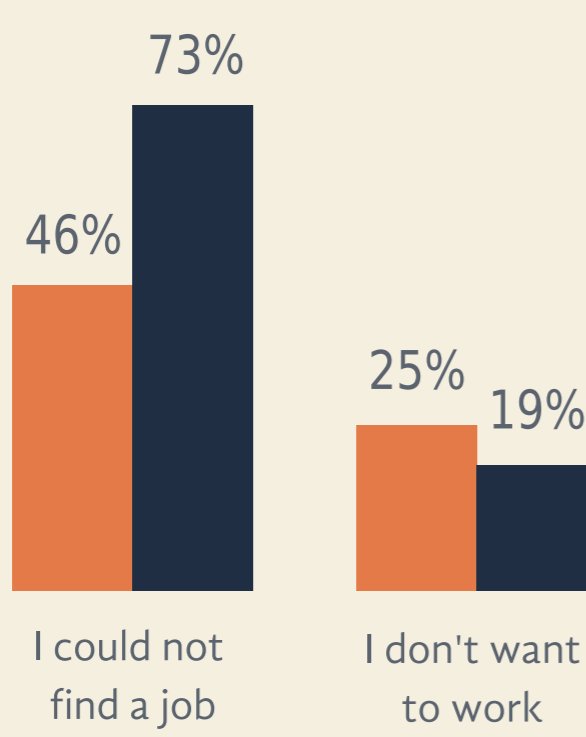
However, women's unemployment rate is 4% lower than men's

Parental leave for fathers as well as for mothers



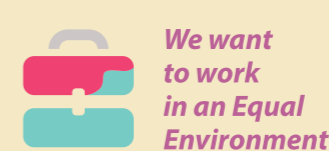
Better distribution of housework between family members
